BENEFITS OF FLU VACCINATION

- Vaccination is still the best way to avoid contracting influenza
- Protecting yourself from flu also protects the people around you who are more vulnerable to serious flu illness
- Flu vaccination can help shield people at greater risk of getting seriously ill from flu, like older adults, people with chronic health conditions, and young children (especially infants younger than 6 months who are too young for vaccination)
- The flu vaccine may make your illness milder if you do get sick
- Flu vaccination can reduce the risk of more serious flu outcomes, like hospitalizations

VACCINE INFO

Quadrivalent (designed to protect against two influenza A and two influenza B viruses).

No latex or thimerosal.

The "high dose" flu vaccine (for people 65 and older) will not be available at this event.
