Activities in the Matanuska Valley

Musk Ox Farm

- Located at Mile 50 of the Glenn Highway, just north of Palmer.
- Tour this working farm and observe these prehistoric survivors from the last ice age.

Transportation & Industry Museum of Alaska

- Located at 3800 W. Museum Drive, off Mile 47 of the Glenn Highway, Wasilla, Alaska.
- Tour the Bush Pilot Hall of Fame; see vintage cars, vintage radio and communication equipment, gold mining exhibit, railroad exhibit and many other exhibits.

Iditarod Trail Sled Dog Race Headquarters

- Go on a dog sled (cart) ride, tour the museum and see the trophies, displays and photos.
- Located at Mile 2.2, Knik Road, Wasilla, Alaska.

Dorothy Page Museum

- Located at 323 North Main Street, Wasilla, Alaska.
- Built in 1931, this log museum was originally a community hall and used for social functions, dances, theater, politics, funerals, and weddings, to name a few.

Independence Mine State Historical Park

- In 1974, the Independence Mine was placed into the National Register of Historical Places. Located in Hatcher Pass, gold was discovered here in 1906 and a lode mine was developed.
- This 271 acre park includes a tour of the mine and the mine manager's house, which houses the visitor center. You can take a self-tour or sign up for a guided tour. The Assay Office has displays about assaying, retorting and other mining techniques.
